Position Description

The Boulder County Transportation Department is seeking a **Regional Trails Planner-Planner II** to assist with the implementation of the County's Regional Trails program. The position reports to the Alternative Transportation Coordinator in the Planning Division and serves within a team structure. While working cooperatively with the transportation planning and engineering staff, the Parks and Open Space staff, the regional transportation staff, other jurisdictional partners, and the general public, duties will include: overseeing project management for trails planning, design and construction; developing trails plans, signing plans, and operational plans for existing and planned trail networks; providing consultant management, to include coordinating with State and Federal funding organizations; assisting with submission of State and Federal grant applications; coordinating with property owners and jurisdictional partners; overseeing environmental review processes; managing and leading public processes; coordinating trails operations planning; and performing other related duties as required.

Qualifications

Requires a Bachelor's degree in Planning, Engineering, Landscape Architecture, Environmental Science or a related field and two years of professional experience in transportation planning, engineering, project management or a related field. A graduate degree in planning or engineering is preferred. Requires a working knowledge of existing laws and regulations that apply to funding, designing, and constructing federally and locally funded transportation projects. Must have the ability to communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing and have the ability to work effectively with other employees, agencies and the public. Must have a working knowledge of Word, Microsoft Excel, and ESRI geographical database programs. An understanding of project management software is preferred. Must possess and maintain a valid Colorado driver's license.
